



## DIAMOND DIGHUDVIBES RIDDICK





Naire: Diamond, you're officially Billiards Music's first featured artist. How does it feel to be the first?







Naire: So, let's start at the beginning—where are you from, who is DJ GHUD Vibes?



Diamond: I'm from Chesapeake,
Virginia, but I also spent time in
Lynchburg. Now, I'm living in Virginia
Beach. I've moved around a bit, but I'll
always be a country girl at heart. That
said, the beach life is growing on me!

Naire: What inspired you to become a DJ? How did that journey start?





Naire: That's incredible. When did you realize you were ready to take DJing seriously?

Diamond: I was organizing events at a lounge in Virginia Beach back in 2018-2019. I was curating shows and bringing in artists and DJs. That's when I started getting serious about the music scene. But after I had my son, I took a break. My significant other was a big inspiration for me, and on my birthday, they surprised me with my first DJ controller. From there, I dove in and started really practicing.



Diamond: I'm all about supporting local music. I make it a point to go to open mics, shows, and events because I believe in experiencing the artists in person. Seeing their stage presence and personality helps me understand their music more deeply. Virginia has such a unique sound, and it's different from anywhere else. When I mix local artists' tracks into my sets, it brings a fresh vibe that you won't hear anywhere else.

Naire: You're balancing so much—running Vibe Studio, hosting a podcast, and still DJing. What's the bigger picture? What's the dream?




Naire: It's clear that you're passionate about creating a safe environment for creatives. Is that something that stems from your own experiences as a woman in the DJ scene?

Diamond: I've got a five-year plan for Vibe Studio. We offer photography, videography, podcasting, artist development, and DJ services. My goal is to create a safe, creative space where people can thrive. The entertainment industry can be tough, and I want to build a place where artists feel supported and free to create without limitations. Ultimately, I want to expand, get a bigger space, and develop a strong artist development program where we can help artists grow and succeed.

Diamond: Definitely. Being a woman in this industry comes with challenges. I've been underpaid, and I've had people try to take advantage. Instead of letting it get to me, I've focused on creating my own opportunities. I've walked away from gigs where things didn't feel right, and that's okay. Not all money is good money. I stand on my business, and I want to create spaces where people can trust the process and feel safe.







Diamond: I'm a loner at heart, so I enjoy spending time by myself, just listening to music. My favorite artist is Kehlani, and her music inspires me. Listening to sounds that excite me helps me discover new tracks and ideas for my sets. I try not to stress over it—I want the process to be fun and organic.

Naire: Kehlani is amazing! Are there any songs or albums that you're especially into right now?


